Hawthorn will then be moving on to measurement of time, length and area.</p> <p>Towards the end of the term we will be learning about fractions and decimals incorporating money.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>History</b></p> <p>In history we will be continuing with our Ancient Greek topic, looking at the individual gods, Greek culture and Greek buildings to name a few.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Geography</b></p> <p>Following our history topic we will be thinking about the movement of the earth! Volcanoes and earthquakes are interesting natural disaster and Class Hawthorn will be learning why and how they occur and the impact they have on people and the area.
